# Cumberland Dance Week

Cumberland Dance Week (CDW) is an all-inclusive music and dance experience on the Cumberland plateau in south central Kentucky. Whether you're looking for a high-energy dance camp, a stress-free and enriching family vacation, a chance to jam with some fabulous musicians, or an opportunity to try something new, Cumberland is for you.

Age-appropriate classes are offered during the morning, afternoon, and evening for children, teens, and adults. Live music is featured throughout the daily schedule. Three times a day, everyone comes together to share dance and music in the tradition of our ancestors. During the evening dance, parents enjoy themselves while their children are tucked away in bed, with staff monitoring the halls.

## Location and Facilities

Kentucky Leadership Center is a spacious, modern facility remotely located on forested hills above beautiful Lake Cumberland near Nancy, Kentucky. Three excellent wooden dance floors, residence rooms, and dining hall are all located under one roof. Residence rooms provide hotel style accommodations with air conditioning and private baths. A large covered porch with rockers and a fireside lobby provide areas for fellowship, relaxation, and impromptu jam sessions. Parents feel comfortable knowing this is a safe environment for their children. Wireless Internet access is available in central areas.

## Highlights

- ◆ **Staff:** More than **20** talented callers, musicians, and teachers.
- ◆ **Dance:** Wide variety of classes—Contra, English, Squares, Waltz, International, Hot Contras, etc. Nightly dance parties, *plus* three late-night dances.
- ◆ **Children's Classes:** Six daily sessions for ages 5-8 & 9-12. Wee Tots program for 4 & under.
- ◆ **Teen Classes:** High energy & creativity —Rapper Sword, Swing, Contra, Squares, Ballroom, etc.
